



Fight Aphids and Nematodes

Aphids feed by sucking fluids out of alfalfa plants. Heavily infested plants wilt during the hottest part of the day. Aphids also may transmit viruses which cause mottling, yellowing, or curling of leaves and stunting of plant growth.

Stem Nematodes are the most serious nematode for alfalfa. A stem nematode infection destroys chloroplasts causing "white flags," or pale leaf tissue. When established, stem nematodes can severely limit productivity for two to three years.
